The Court finds that even though Election Day is a state holiday, it may be necessary for the Court to conduct election related business. The Court ORDERS that the Henrico Circuit Court Clerk's Office be available to receive election related filings until 9:00 pm on Election Day.

Only election related issues will be addressed on Election Day. The Court will determine if a hearing is necessary. Any hearing will be conducted as promptly as possible. Normal filings will not be accepted.
