UPDATE: Henrico Police Looking for Hit and Run Suspect

(Henrico County, Va.) – The victim of this hit-and-run incident has been identified as Latanya Cousins, 51, of Richmond. She has succumbed to injuries she sustained from the incident.

(Henrico County, Va.) – On September 5, 2022, at approximately 11:13 pm, Henrico Police responded to the area of Mechanicsville Turnpike and Crump Street for the report of a pedestrian struck by a car. The pedestrian, an adult female, was attempting to cross Mechanicsville Turnpike when a vehicle traveling West struck her. The vehicle did not stop and continued driving, running the red light at Magnolia Street.

Henrico Police and Henrico Fire arrived shortly after the incident and transported the victim to an area hospital with life-threatening injuries. Due to the extent of her injuries, at this time, investigators have not been able to identify the victim who currently remains in critical condition at the hospital. She is described as a black female, possibly in her fifties, 5 foot tall, 100 lbs, very thin. She was found wearing blue jeans, multicolored tennis shoes, multi-colored socks, and a dark blue shirt.

Investigators are also looking for any information the public may have pertaining to the suspect. Surveillance video provided by an area business caught the incident on camera. The video shows the victim being struck on the front passenger side of the vehicle, knocking the victim into the air and then coming to rest in the westbound turn lane. Investigators are seeking the public's assistance with being able to identify the suspect or vehicle that was involved.

**Motor Vehicle Crash – Vehicle vs Pedestrian (Hit and Run)
2300 Block of Mechanicsville Turnpike – (Henrico County)**

(Henrico County, Va.) On Monday, September 5th, 2022, at approximately 11:12 pm Henrico Police Emergency Communications received a call for service regarding a Motor Vehicle Crash that transpired in the 2300 Block of Mechanicsville Turnpike near Bloom Lane. Responding Officers located one injured female in the west bound travel lanes of Mechanicsville Turnpike. She was ultimately transported to MCV for treatment with her status being unknown at this time. Suspect vehicle fled the scene, west on Mechanicsville Turnpike prior to being identified. Officers canvassed the area for additional evidence as well as injured parties, but none were located.
