APPLICATION OF FORCE OCCURRENCES

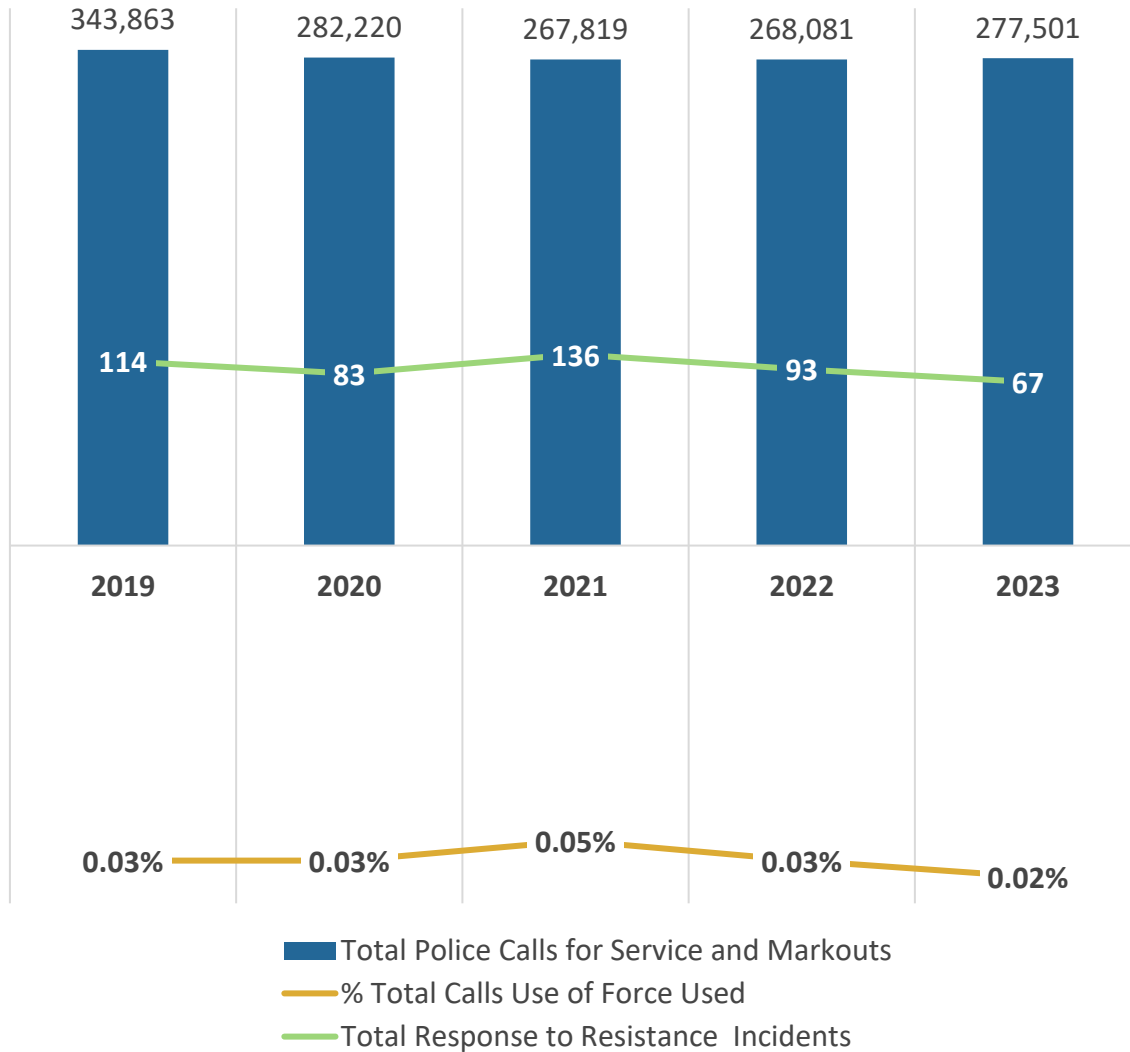
There were twenty-six (26) less responses to resistance during 2023 than the previous year, a 27.96% decrease, despite responding to 9,200 more service calls. The prior three-year average is 104 responses to resistance. There was a 35.6% reduction in responses from this average during 2023.

The Henrico County Police Division experienced a repeated and significant decrease in the number of response to resistance incidents in 2023 from the prior two years. Officers' responses to resistance were less than half of the 2021 quantity.



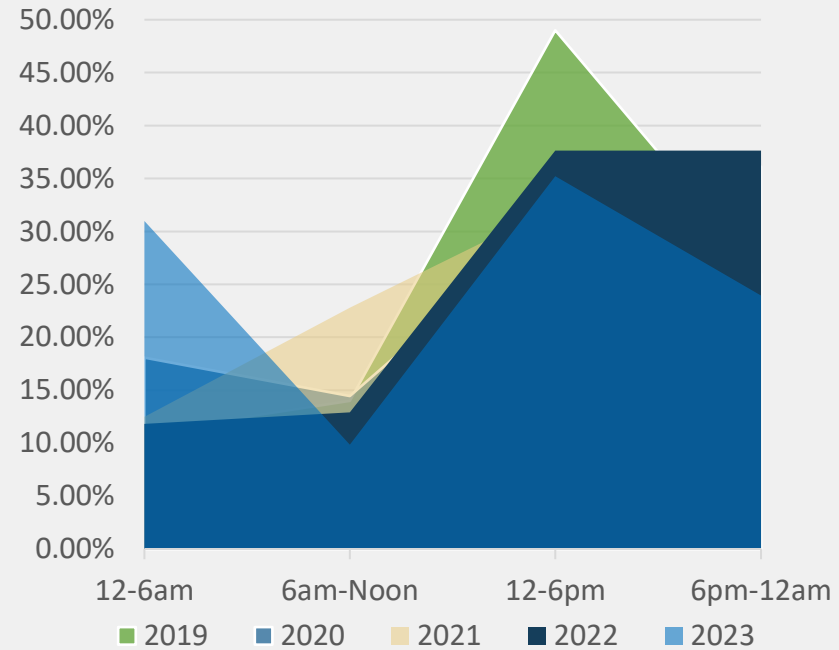
APPLICATION OF FORCE OCCURRENCES

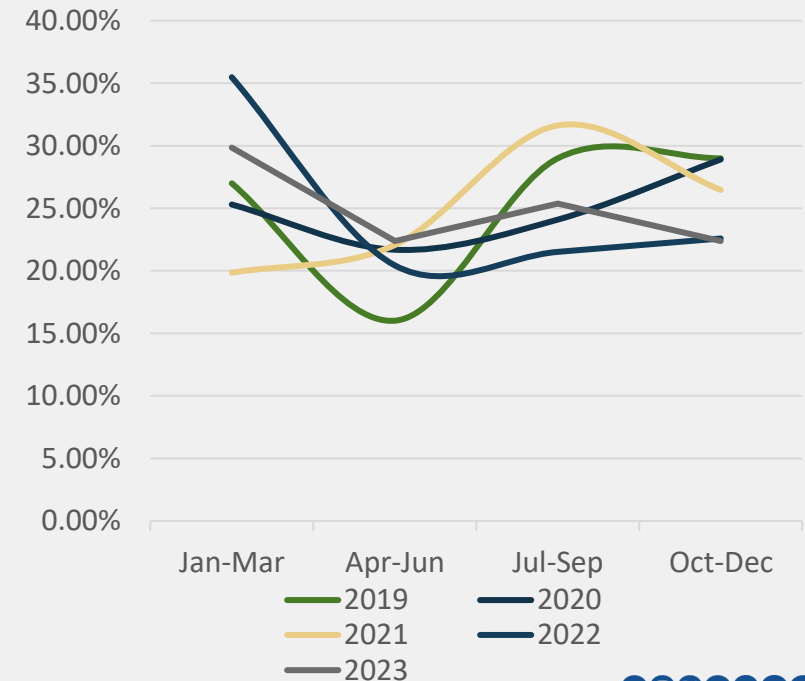

TIME OF DAY RESISTANCE INCIDENTS OCCUR, 2019-2023



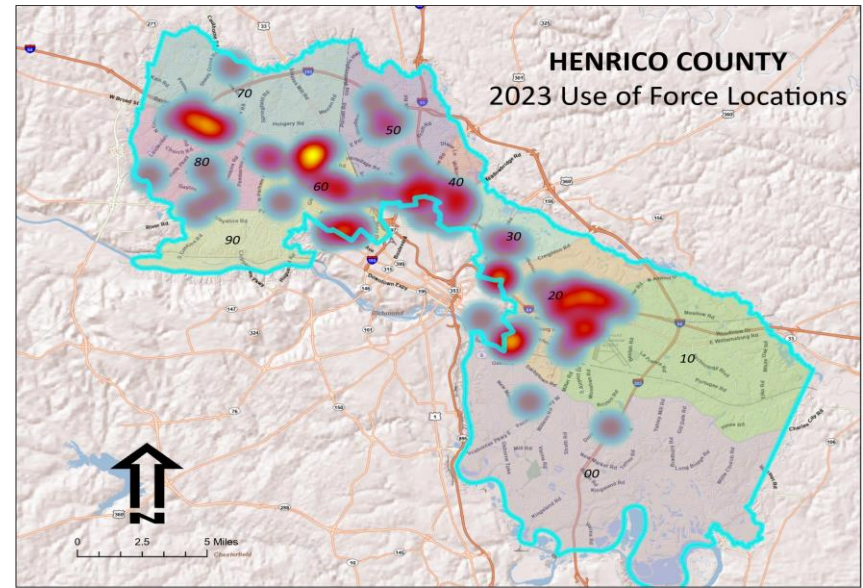
TIME OF YEAR RESISTANCE INCIDENTS OCCUR, 2019-2023





2023 HENRICO POLICE CRIME STATISTICS APPLICATION OF FORCE OCCURRENCES

In 2023, **Patrol West Station** accounted for 35.23% of response to resistance incidents, **Patrol Central** for 22.73%, and **Patrol South** responded to 26.14% of the incidents.

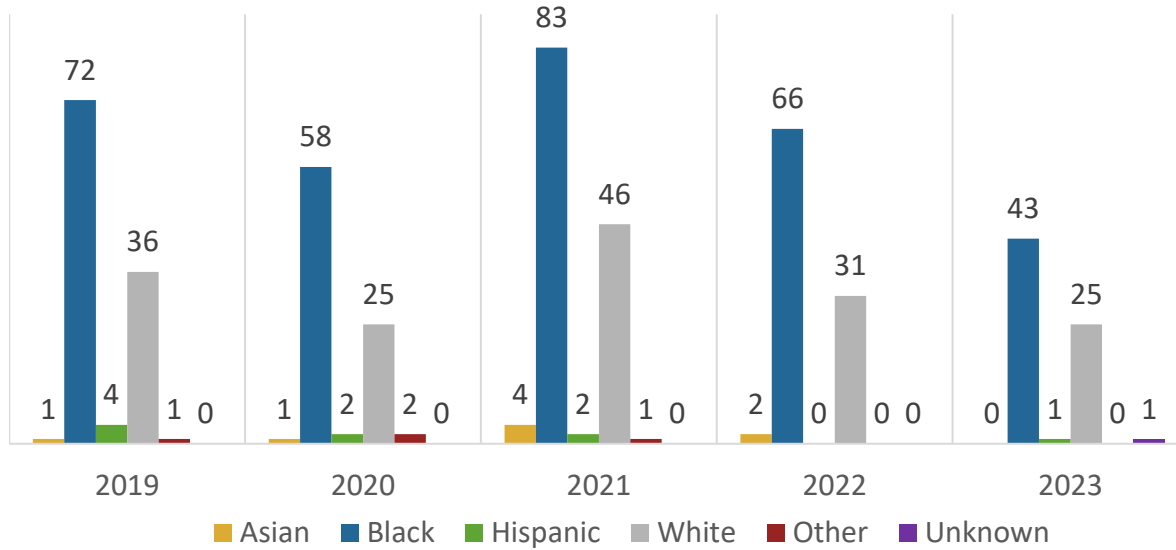

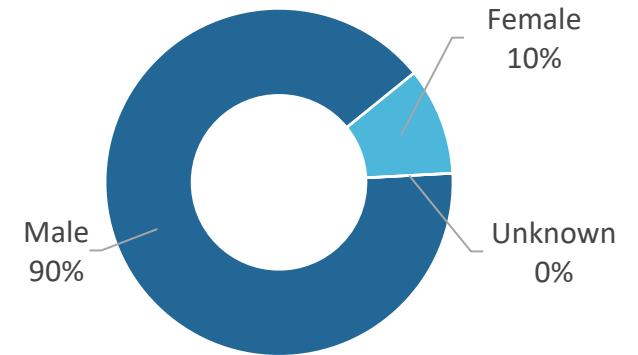
APPLICATION OF FORCE DEMOGRAPHICS

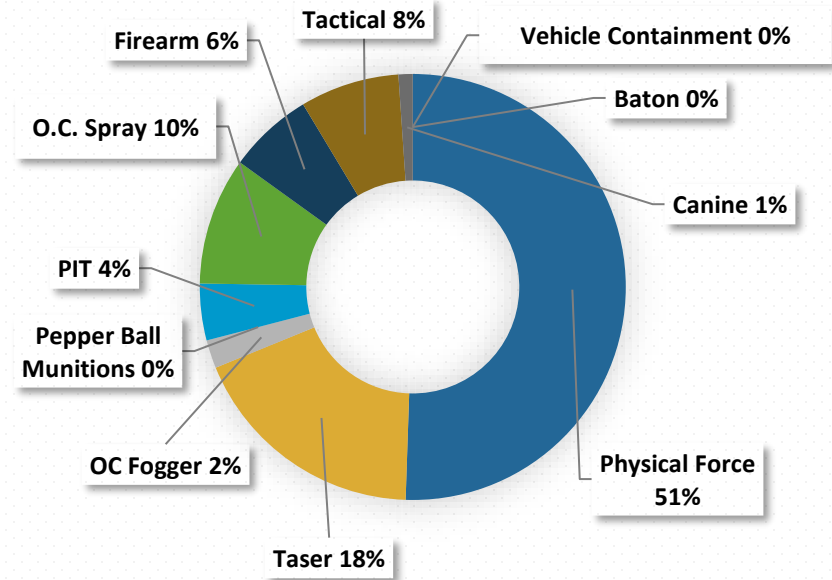

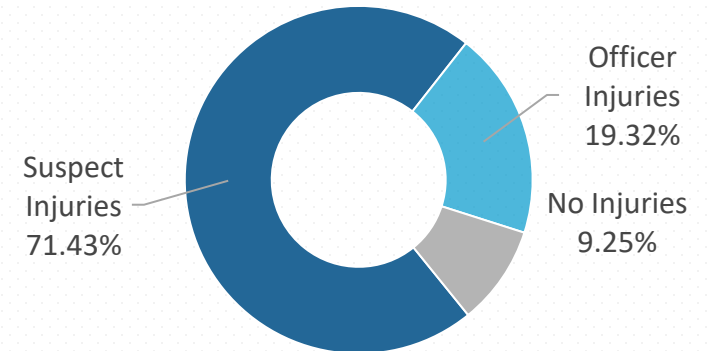

INJURIES FROM USE OF FORCE INCIDENTS, 2023



Injuries are defined for reporting purposes as pain/soreness, bruising/swelling, abrasions/lacerations, exposure to chemical agents or Taser barbs, fractures, stabbing/ gunshot/puncture wounds or other injuries not experienced prior to the encounter. Police Division policy strictly dictates appropriate medical intervention for injured persons, including for perceived minor injuries.
