- Each citizen is limited to two full boxes (10"x13"x18")
 OR three full paper grocery bags.
 - Please remove all paperclips, binder clips, 3-ring binders, bound books, metal spirals in notebooks, file folders, plastic sleeves, etc.
 Personal documents only!

Electronics that are accepted free of charge:



- Monitors
- Computers
- Printers
- Computer Peripherals
- Audio/Stereo Equipment
- VCRs
- DVD Players
- Video Cameras

- Wireless Devices
- Video Game Consoles
- Kitchen Appliances

Costs for certain electronics:

CRT TVs, 27 inches or less: \$25 CRT TVs. 28 inches or more: \$35

LCD TVs, 46 inches or less: **\$20** LCD TVs, 47 inches or more: **\$30**

Projection TVs: \$30

Items that are NOT accepted:

Compact fluorescent light bulbs, refrigerators, dehumidifiers, AC units, and other items such as clothing or batteries that are not considered an electronic.
