## APPLICATION OF FORCE OCCURRENCES

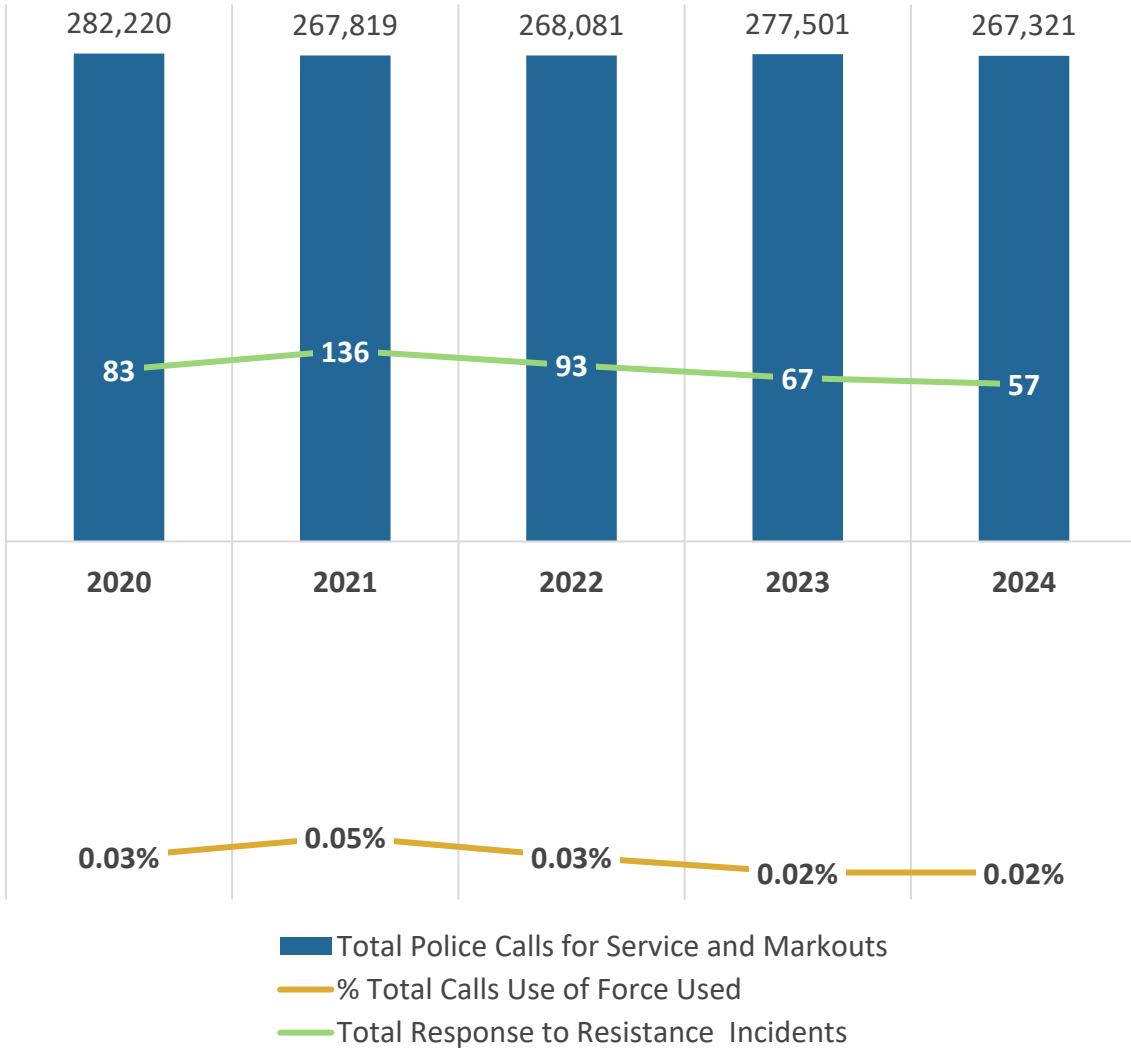
There were ten (10) fewer responses to resistance during 2024 than the previous year, a 14.9% decrease, correlated to 10,180 fewer service calls and markouts. The prior three-year average is 98 responses to resistance. There was a 41.8% reduction in responses from this average during 2024.

The Henrico County Police Division experienced a repeated decrease in the number of response to resistance incidents in 2024 from the prior two years.



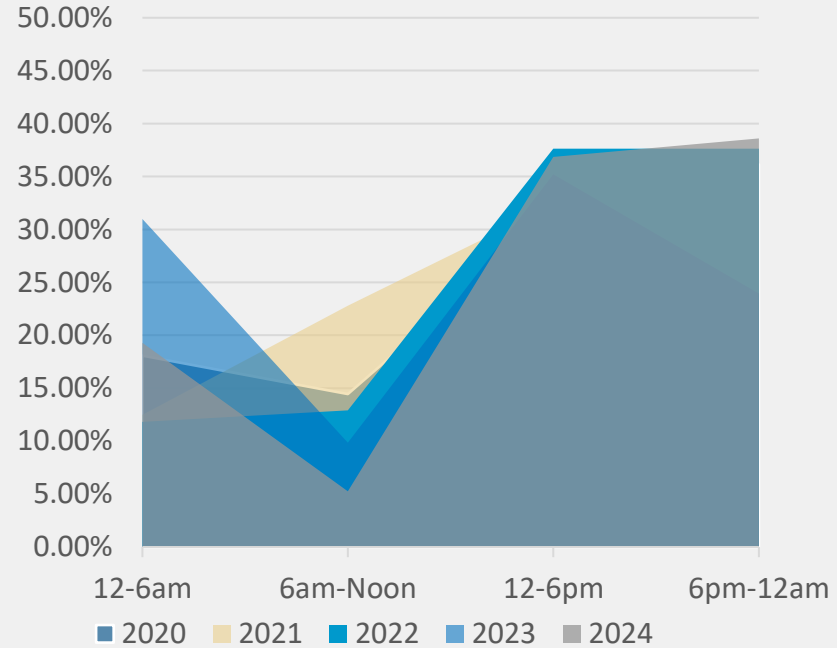

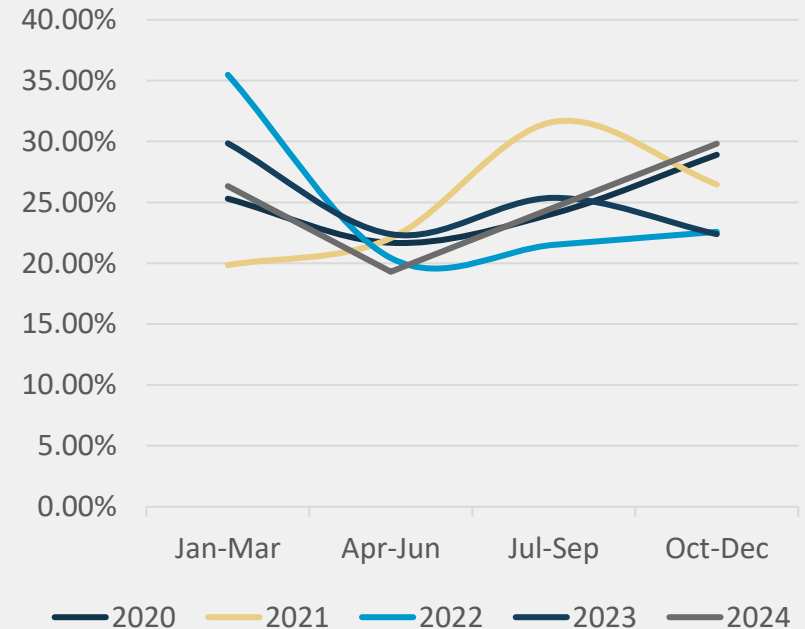

TIME OF DAY RESISTANCE INCIDENTS OCCUR, 2020-2024



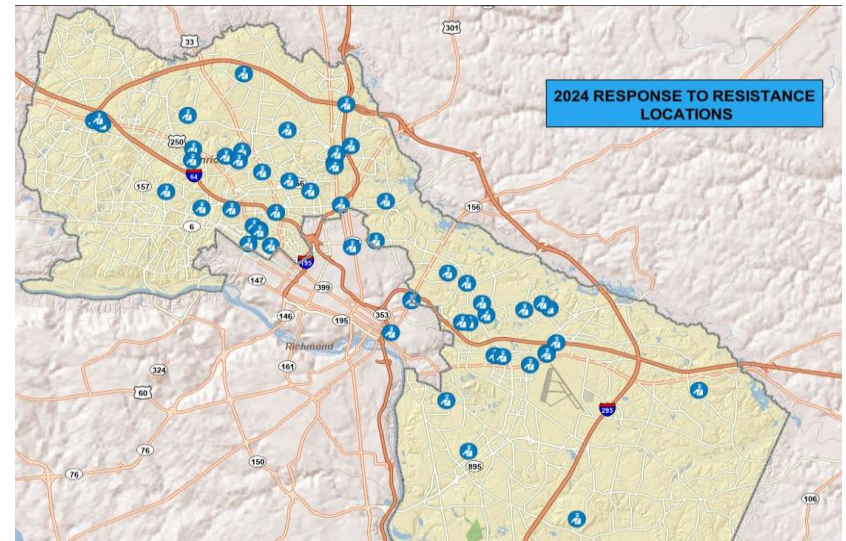
TIME OF YEAR RESISTANCE INCIDENTS OCCUR, 2020-2024





## 2024 HENRICO POLICE CRIME STATISTICS APPLICATION OF FORCE OCCURRENCES

In 2024, **Patrol West Station** accounted for 32.43% of response to resistance incidents, **Patrol Central** for 14.86%, and **Patrol South** responded to 27.03% of the incidents.

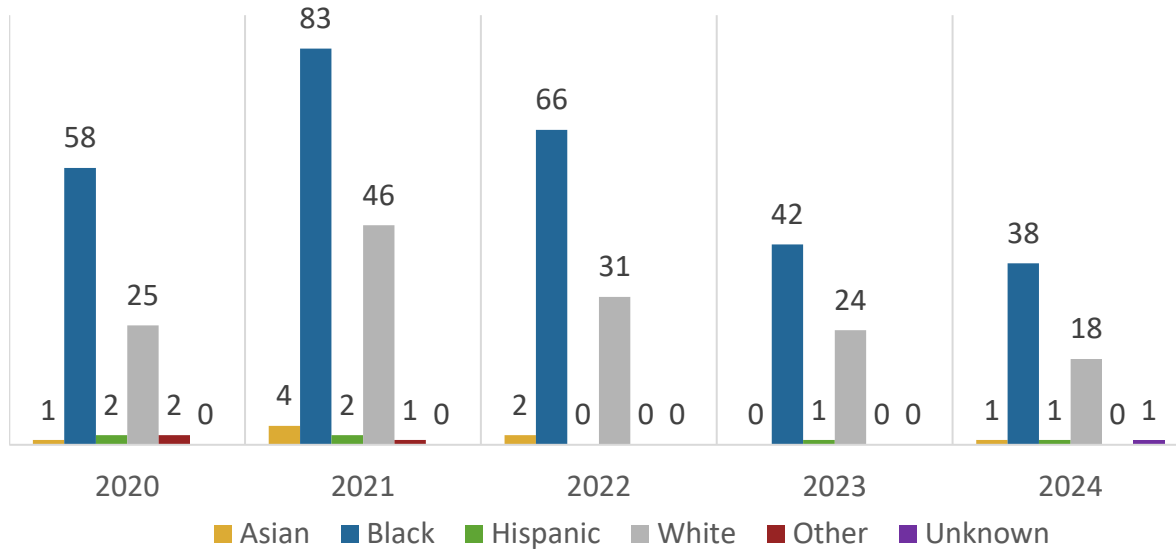

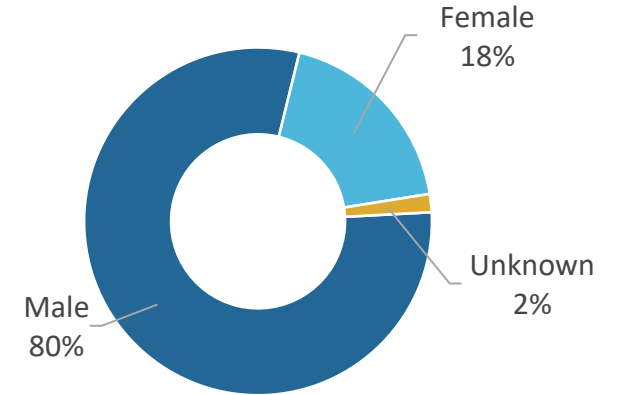
APPLICATION OF FORCE DEMOGRAPHICS

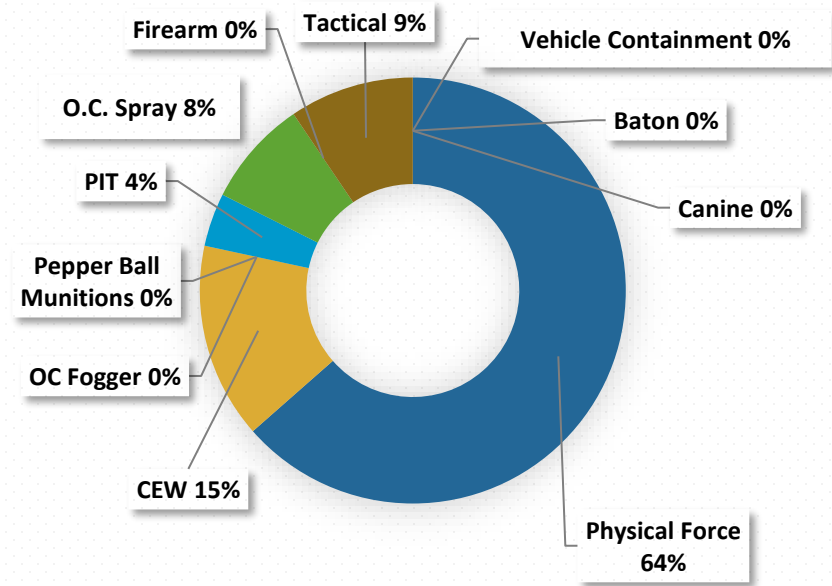

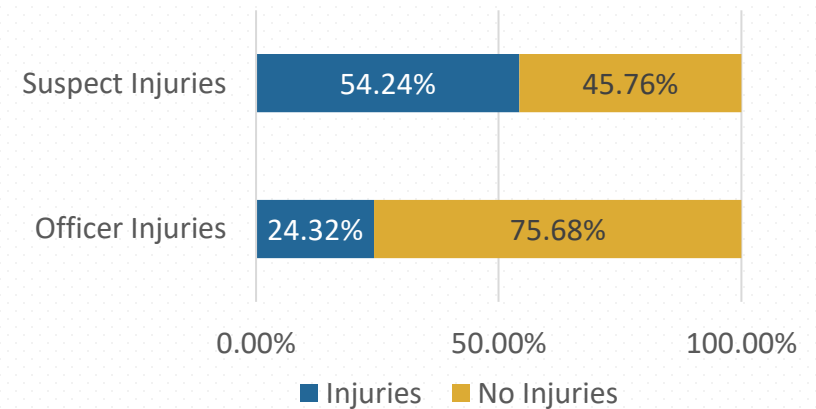

## INJURIES FROM USE OF FORCE INCIDENTS, 2024



Injuries are defined for reporting purposes as pain/soreness, bruising/swelling, abrasions/lacerations, exposure to chemical agents or Taser barbs, fractures, stabbing/ gunshot/puncture wounds or other injuries not experienced prior to the encounter. Police Division policy strictly dictates appropriate medical intervention for injured persons, including for perceived minor injuries.
