# Introduction

During calendar year 2025, there were 78 response to resistance incidents from the combined 257,479 calls for service and markouts, for a .03% response rate. This is an increase of 36.8% (21 incidents) from 2024. This still falls below the five-year average of 86.2 and is 42.65% lower than the peak of 136 in 2021.

The Henrico County Police Division experienced a consistent percentage of response rates compared to previous years.

Individual reported injuries continued to decrease significantly by 21.29% from 2024 to 2025. However, officer injuries rose slightly during the same time frame. Subject injuries are about 20% below the five-year average and officer injuries are consistent with the five-year average.

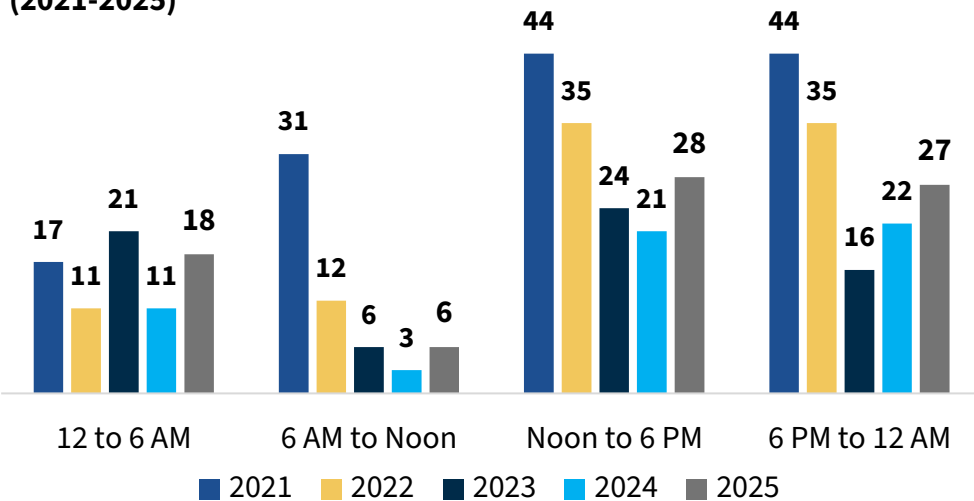

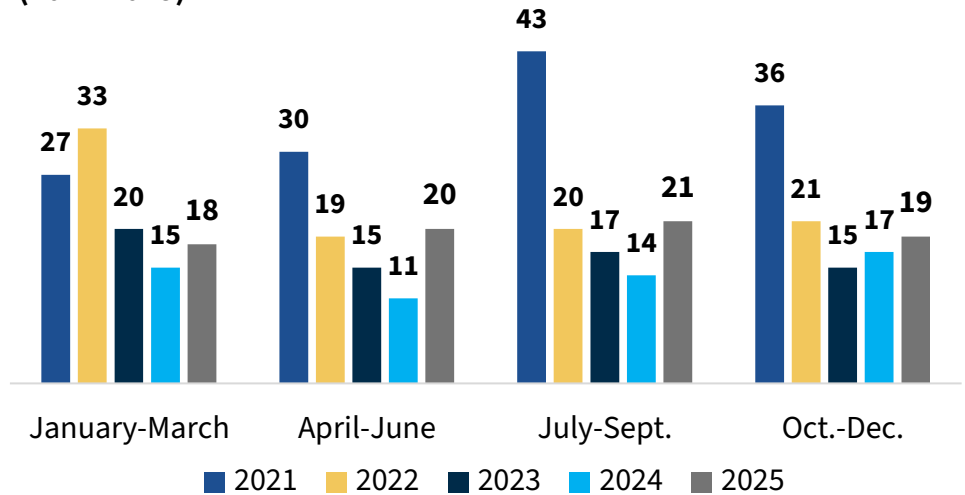

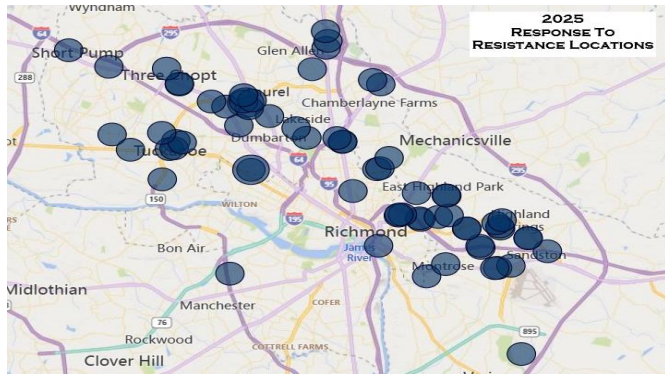

In 2025, **Patrol West Station** accounted for 28.24% of response to resistance incidents, **Patrol Central** for 35.29%, and **Patrol South** responded to 23.53% of the incidents.

The **Special Operations Bureau**, consisting of the Emergency Services Unit (Emergency Response Team, Canine Unit, EOD, and Civil Disturbance Team) and the Traffic Enforcement Unit, accounted for 7.06% of response incidents.

In 2025, the subjects involved in use of force incidents ranged from age 14 to 63 years old, with an average age of 31.34 years old.

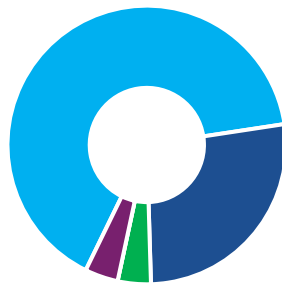
Officers reported that male subjects were primarily involved in response to resistance instances, accounting for 96.15%, compared to 3.85% of female subjects requiring similar responses.

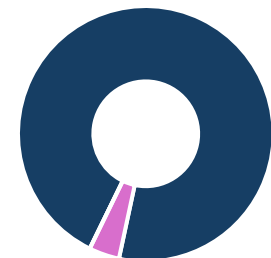
2025 TOTAL USE OF FORCE SUBJECTS BY RACE/ETHNICITY

The table shows the total number of applications of force applied by type to all use of force incidents between 2021 and 2025. In 2025, an application of force was applied 88 times. Physical force (62.36%) was applied 54 times, the highest during the calendar year compared to other types. Officers utilized their firearm once (1.14%) in 2025 to address an aggressive dog.

Please note, an incident and/or individual may necessitate multiple applications of force.

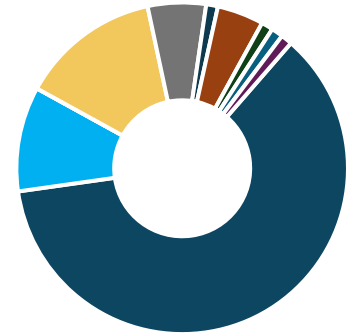

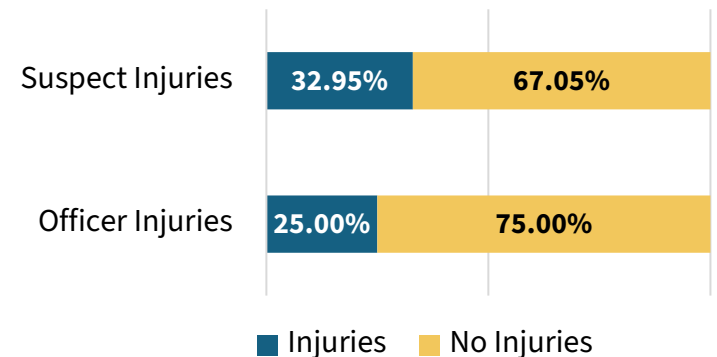

Injuries are defined for reporting purposes as pain/soreness, bruising/swelling, abrasions/lacerations, exposure to chemical agents or CEW barbs, fractures, stabbing/gunshot/puncture wounds, or other injuries not experienced prior to the encounter. Police Division policy strictly dictates appropriate medical intervention for injured persons, including for perceived minor injuries. Medical clearance may be granted at the injury scene or from a medical facility.
