Henrico Police Investigates Fatal Bicycle Crash

Update 1:

(Henrico County, Va.) - Henrico Police has identified the victim involved in Friday's fatal bicyclist crash.

On Friday, June 7, 2024, at approximately 9:47 p.m., Henrico Police responded to the intersection of Staples Mill Road and Waller Road for a reported crash involving a bicyclist. Once on scene, officers located an adult male lying in the westbound lanes of Staples Mill Road. He was pronounced deceased at the scene.

Henrico Police Crash Team Investigators have identified the victim as **Albert Woodrow Miller**, **60**, **of Montpelier**.

The preliminary investigation indicates the driver of a vehicle was traveling west on Staples Mill Road through the intersection at Waller Road when Mr. Miller was struck on his bicycle. The driver involved in the crash remained on scene.

Investigators believe dark-colored attire, alcohol and failure to obey a red light by Mr. Miller contributed to this crash.

(Henrico County, Va.) – On June 7th, 2024, at approximately 9:47 pm Henrico Police responded to a report of a bicyclist struck by a vehicle at the intersection of Staples Mill Rd. and Waller Rd. Upon arrival officers found a male laying in the roadway. The bicyclist was pronounced deceased at the scene. The driver that struck the bicyclist remained at the scene. This is still an active investigation. Motorists are asked to avoid the area of Staples Mill Rd. and Waller Rd. while police investigate the accident. Westbound traffic on Staples Mill Rd. at Waller Rd. will be closed until the scene is cleared.
