Henrico Police Investigating Virginia Center Parkway and Wylie Lane Shooting

(Henrico County, Va.) – Henrico Police is now investigating this incident as a homicide.

On August 4, 2024, at approximately 2:28 a.m., Henrico Police responded to the intersection of Virginia Center Parkway and Wylie Lane for the report of a shooting. Once on scene, officers located an adult male victim suffering from life-threatening injuries. The victim was transported by Henrico Fire to an area hospital where they succumbed to their injuries sustained from the shooting.

The victim has been identified as **Deondre Jermaine Spinks, 33, of Richmond.**

Members from Henrico Police's Criminal Investigations Section are actively working to understand the circumstances surrounding this incident. As of this release, there is currently no suspect information that investigators are able to share as they continue to follow up on leads and collect evidence.

Watch Commander Release:

(Henrico County, Va.) – On August 4th, 2024, at 02:28am, Officers responded to the intersection of Virginia Center Pkwy and Wylie lane for a possible shooting. When Officers arrived on scene, they located one male subject with a gunshot wound to the stomach. He was transported with life threatening injuries to a local hospital. Members of the Criminal Investigations team are on scene and actively investigating.
