### Henrico Police Investigates Fatal Pedestrian Crash on Brook Road

**(Henrico County, Va.)** – Henrico Police is investigating a fatal pedestrian crash that in the Fairfield District.

On Thursday, October 3, 2024, at approximately 8:48 p.m., Henrico Police responded to the 5200 block of Brook Road for a reported auto versus pedestrian crash. Once on scene, officers located an adult female pedestrian with serious injuries. She was transported to an area hospital for treatment but succumbed to her injuries early Friday morning.

Henrico Police Crash Investigators have identified the victim as **Barbara Robinson, 57, of Henrico.**

The preliminary investigation indicates Ms. Robinson was crossing the roadway in the 5200 block of Brook Road when she was struck by a BMW traveling southbound. The driver of the BMW remained on scene and is cooperating with authorities. Investigators continue to look into the cause of the crash.
