Henrico Police Investigates Fatal Single-Vehicle Crash on Woodman Rd.

(Henrico County, Va.) – Henrico Police is investigating a fatal single-vehicle crash that occurred in the Fairfield Magisterial District.

On Sunday, Jan. 11, 2026, around 6:55 p.m., Henrico Police responded to the intersection of Woodman Road and Woodman Hills Court for a reported single-vehicle crash. Once on scene, officers located a Mazda 6 along the northbound side of the tree line with an adult male inside. He was pronounced deceased at the scene.

Henrico Police Crash Investigators have identified the deceased as **Cody Lee Page, 33, of Glen Allen.**

The preliminary investigation indicates Mr. Page was tailgating another vehicle heading north on Woodman Road when he attempted to pass the vehicle on the right shoulder. The vehicle went off of the roadway and struck several trees before flipping over and coming to rest along the tree line. Henrico Police believe speed and alcohol are factors in this crash.
