Henrico Police Investigates Dozens of Vehicle Larcenies and Vandalisms

(Henrico County, Va.) – Henrico Police is investigating a string of larcenies that occurred overnight across the entire county.

On Wednesday, March 11, 2026, between 4 a.m. and 8 a.m., Henrico Police responded to several calls for reported car break-ins and vandalism. Between Henrico’s east end and west end, nearly 40 vehicles were hit. Victims reported personal items were stolen from the vehicles and nearly all had smashed windows.

These incidents occurred in the following locations:

- 400 block International Centre Drive
- 9900 Mayland Drive
- 11000 block W. Broad Street
- 12000 block W. Broad Street
- 200 Towne Center West Boulevard

“There is a strong indication this crime spree is tied to the same individual(s),” said **Henrico Police spokesperson Karina Bolster**. “Currently officers are working with the victims and the businesses of the properties to obtain as much evidence as possible to identify a person or persons of interest.”

The preliminary investigation indicates the thief or thieves traveled along the I-64 corridor and stopped at a number of the hotels nearby to commit their crimes.
