Question: What is your vision for Belmont?

- Mutual support from Lakeside area businesses
- The best public course in VA
- Good ideas tonight, build upon them. Keep Belmont going.
- GOLF
- A golf course that is a major draw for people all over the state and beyond!
- Bring Pro Tournaments
- Walking, biking trails for neighbors and public multi-use facilities
- Please keep Belmont an 18-hole golf course. Invest the \$300,000 bequeathed monies into repairs and upgrade. Do some advertising. Promote tournaments – mens, womens, kids etc. If people need a dog park or multi-use park in our neighborhood – please use the triangle piece of land at the bottom of the hill (the old trailer park.) You can put a multiuse park anywhere. Belmont is historic. Please leave it an 18-hole course.
- A shining example of what public golf should be – accessible by all, a 18-hole gem.
- Maintain 18-hole golf course. Add walking/biking on perimeter if possible.
- Remain 18-hole golf course. If people want a proper dog park, please use the triangular parcel of land by The Dump or use that triangular parcel for a putting course, but please leave Belmont Golf Course alone. Put some \$ into repairs and upgrades and advertising.
- Belmont Golf Course is a gem! Do not let this historic golf course be converted to a soccer/baseball/dog park mush-up thing!
- Remain an 18-hole course but run it like the business it's supposed to be.
- Make it a place for all residents, not just golf/tennis, add trails...
- Have a recreation facility that is usable by a broad range of residents.
- Henrico county needs a golf course! As one of the best run Counties in the USA, Henrico County should leverage the Belmont asset to become one of the best public access golf facilities in the USA. Henrico County has over 1,000 acres of undeveloped land and this/these lands can be developed for "regular" parkland.
