




### INTRODUCTION

- **Purpose of Study:** Explore policies and tools to manage change within the framework of the comprehensive plan








# RESULTS OF PUBLIC INPUT

- 58% Enter Site Directly








Image 1: Parking located in the front of the building





Image 2: Parking located at the side or rear






Image 1: Buildings fronting the street with landscaping buffer






Image 1: Traditional design






Image 1: Manicured parking lot landscaping






Image 1: Formal landscape along street




Image 2: Natural landscape along street






Image 1: Conservation subdivision





Image 2: Traditional subdivision








Image 1: Grid street network






Image 1: Single access point on road with cul-de-sac development






Image 1: Rural design (no curb & gutter)






Image 1: Rural design (no curb & gutter)




Image 2: Suburban design (curb & gutter)






Image 1: Traditional neighborhood development with sidewalks, curb, and gutter








Image 1: Residential development screened from the road






Image: Rural-style wood sign






Image: Multi-tenant pole sign






Image: Low-profile monument sign with stone base






Image: Low-profile monument sign with electronic messaging






Image: Pedestrian-oriented decorative street lamps







Image: Pedestrian oriented light with banner pole




Image: LED full cut-off parking lot light






Image: Mixed use town square







Image: Town square with gazebo and benches






Image: Produce stand






Image 1: Rural town center







Image 1: Mixed use town center




Image 2: Rural town center


