Did you know...

[Henrico County Municipal Code](#) (Chapter 5) prohibits dogs from running at large.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW WHEN IT COMES TO CURBING YOUR DOG

- Keep your pet on a leash at all times to prevent altercations with other animals and to protect them from cars and other vehicles.
- Keep your pet on your own property to defecate and urinate.
- Clean up after your pet defecates to protect you and your pet from diseases which can be in puppy or dog feces.

- Never let your pet defecate on another's private property.
- Be considerate. If your dog defecates on public or another person's private property, please clean up after your dog for the health and safety of others.
- Always wash your hands after curbing your dog.

WALKING YOUR DOG IN A HENRICO COUNTY PARK

Per the [Henrico County Municipal Code \(Chapter 14\)](#), all residents and those visiting a county park or recreation facility **must keep their dogs on a leash**, unless within a designated off-leash area (i.e. fenced-in dog park).
