



## DOG LICENSE APPLICATION

A Henrico County dog license is valid for the life of the dog, as long as the dog's owner resides in Henrico county and valid as long as the dog's rabies vaccination is kept current. A permanent metal tag is issued for the life of the dog. A copy of a valid rabies certificate is required, and must be return with payment in the amount of \$10.00.

Licenses are not prorated and are non-transferable and non-refundable.

Code of the County of Henrico, Virginia Extracts from chapter 5

Sec. 5-49. Requires all dogs four months of age or older to be licensed. \$10 individual lifetime dog license is valid for the life of the dog, and valid as long as the dog's owner resides in Henrico county, and valid as long as the rabies vaccination is kept current.

Kennels shall run for the calendar year. (Jan. 1st- Dec 31st ) Tags & license are not prorated, non-refundable, and non-transferable.

This license tax is in addition to any fee due for a dangerous dog registration certificate

Sec. 5-53. The metal license tag issued for an individual dog is permanent for the life of the dog unless, lost, stolen or destroyed.

Sec. 5-55. If a dog tag should become lost, stolen or destroyed the owner or custodian shall at once apply for a duplicate tag for \$1.00.

Sec. 5-56. Dog license tags shall be securely fastened to a substantial collar by owner or custodian and worn by such dog.

Section 24-4419. By law, Henrico County allows only four adult pets per residence. A conditional use permit may be obtained to allow a private kennel in residential districts. A private kennel is defined as a premises used by the property's occupants for the care of four or more dogs, cats, pets, fowl or domestic animals that are at least four months old for non-commercial purposes.
