FILE OF LIFE PROGRAM

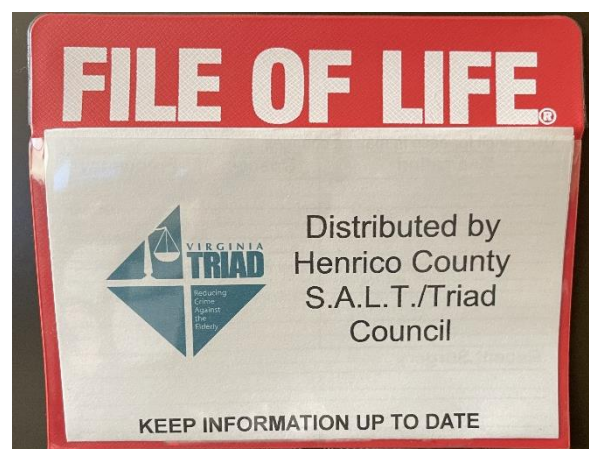
→ QUICKLY AND ACCURATELY PROVIDING IMPORTANT MEDICAL FACTS TO FIRST RESPONDERS

What is this program?

Each **FILE OF LIFE** kit contains a blank medical card, plastic magnetic pocket, and a decal. The card is filled out with name, medical history, medical information, insurance information, and emergency medical contacts.

The medical card slips into the plastic magnetic pocket that protects the card and the patient's privacy. The entire magnetic pocket is attached to the outside of the refrigerator.

A small, highly visible decal is then attached to the front door or window to alert emergency personnel to the presence of the **FILE OF LIFE**.



How can this program work for me?

- Get a **FILE OF LIFE** kit and decal from your nearest library.
- Fill out the card using a pencil.
- Place the card in the plastic **FILE OF LIFE** pocket.
- Place the **FILE OF LIFE** pocket on your refrigerator.
- Place the **FILE OF LIFE** decal on your front door or window.
- Remember to update the information regularly.
