Whereas, the County of Henrico, Virginia (the “County”) and Flock Group Inc. (“Contractor”) entered into Contract No. 2363A (the “Contract”) dated November 7, 2022 to provide Automatic License Plate Readers when needed and requested by the County; and,

Whereas, the original Contract term was from November 15, 2022, to November 14, 2023; and,

Whereas, the parties renewed the Contract for an additional one-year term beginning November 15, 2023 and ending November 14, 2024; and

Whereas, the parties renewed the Contract for an additional one-year term beginning November 15, 2024 and ending November 14, 2025; and

Whereas, the parties renewed the Contract for an additional one-year term beginning November 15, 2025 and ending November 14, 2026; and

Whereas, the Contractor provided notice of a requirement for compliance with Commonwealth of Virginia Code § 2.2-5517 titled “**Exhibit A**”; and,

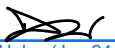
Whereas, the parties mutually agree to incorporate this into the Contract.

EXHIBIT A

VIRGINIA CODE § 2.2-5517 COMPLIANCE

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to ensure compliance with Virginia Code § 2.2-5517 with respect to system data and audit trail data collected or generated in Virginia in connection with the Flock Services; and

WHEREAS, the Parties intend for this Addendum to supplement the Agreement solely with respect to such compliance obligations.

NOW, THEREFORE, the County and Flock agree as follows:

1. **Conflict.** In the event of a conflict between this Exhibit A and the Contract, the terms of this Amendment and Exhibit A will control solely with respect to the subject matter herein.
2. **Definitions.**
 - 2.1. The following terms have the meanings set forth in Va. Code § 2.2-5517(A)
 - 2.1.1. System data
 - 2.1.2. Audit trail data
 - 2.1.3. Audit trail
 - 2.2. Any capitalized terms used in this Addendum will have the same meaning as in the Agreement, unless expressly defined otherwise.
3. **Compliance with Va. Code § 2.2-5517.**
 - 3.1. System data and audit trail data will be the property of the Customer.
 - 3.2. The Flock system meets the requirements set forth in Va. Code § 2.2-5517(B):
 - 3.2.1. Flock certifies that it will not sell or share any system data or audit trail data gathered in Virginia, except upon request of the Customer for a purpose set forth in Va. Code § 2.2-5517(F), and will only access system data or audit trail data upon request of the Customer for maintenance and quality assurance purposes;
 - 3.2.2. Flock certifies that its system is capable of purging system data collected or generated in Virginia after twenty-one (21) days of the date of its capture, or earlier if requested by the Customer, in such a manner that the system data is destroyed and not recoverable by either Flock or the Customer;
 - 3.2.3. Flock certifies that its system is capable of producing an audit trail and purging audit trail data collected or generated in Virginia after two (2) years of the date of its capture in such a manner that the audit trail data is destroyed and not recoverable by either Flock or the Customer;
 - 3.2.4. The databases used by the Flock system to provide notifications as set forth in Va. Code § 2.2-5517(D) are updated at least every twenty-four (24) hours, or as soon as practicable after such updates become available; and
 - 3.2.5. The Flock system meets information security standards as established by the Virginia Information Technologies Agency.
 - 3.3. Flock will immediately notify the Customer upon receipt of any subpoena duces tecum, execution of any search warrant, or any other request from a third party for such system data or audit trail data, unless disclosure of such subpoena duces tecum, search warrant, or request is otherwise prohibited by law.
