Understanding that food is a critical need, Saturday food banks are an opportunity to educate partners and residents about their mission to provide education, advocacy and support to Spanish-speaking individuals affected by violence in Virginia to ensure they have access to services that empower them to become happy, healthy and self-sufficient.
