With the Nov. 2 general election just over a week away, Henrico's <u>Voter</u> <u>Registration and Elections</u> office is reminding voters of approaching key dates and services.

Saturday, Oct. 30 is the last day to vote absentee in person. Saturday inperson absentee voting is scheduled for 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. in the elections offices at the Henrico Government Center, 4305 E. Parham Road, and the Eastern Government Center, 3820 Nine Mile Road, and also at a satellite voting office at Varina Area Library, 1875 New Market Road. Early in-person voting also is available at the elections offices from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. daily through Friday, Oct. 29.

Completed mail-in ballots can also be returned to any of <u>five drop</u> <u>boxes</u> installed across the county.

Polls will open from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Election Day, Tuesday, Nov. 2.

advance a private developer's vision for the \$2.3 billion "ecodistrict" at the site of the former Best Products headquarters. The 200-plus acre, mixed-use community will be anchored by a 17,000-seat arena for major concerts, sporting events and other entertainment.

The following groups are now eligible for a booster shot of the COVID vaccine:

- People 65 years and older
- Residents of long-term care facilities
- Adults at increased risk due to underlying medical conditions or because of where they work or live.
- Recipients of the J&J vaccine who are 18 or older and were vaccinated at least two months ago
