Welcome to the County of Henrico public hearing on the proposed Nuckols Road Pedestrian Improvement project. The purpose of this meeting is to provide an opportunity for the public or organizations to give comments on the proposed project. The County wants all members of the community to have the opportunity to participate in public involvement on project affecting them. The County representatives are present to discuss the project and answer your questions.

A comment sheet is included with the handout for this meeting. All written comments received on this project will be included in a transcript for review by County personnel, citizens, and other interested parties. County staff will address questions and concerns raised as a result of this meeting.

Project Description

The project will provide enhanced safety for pedestrian travel along Nuckols Road by constructing approximately 2,000 linear feet (0.37 miles) of 5-foot sidewalk along the north side of Nuckols Road from Energy Way (formerly Capital One Way) to Springfield Road. The project also includes the provision of new ADA ramps and crosswalk connecting the northeast and southeast quadrants of Energy Way/Nuckols Road/Snowmass Road intersection. This connection will also provide access to the existing sidewalk on the south side of Nuckols Road to enable further connectivity in the vicinity of the project.

Location:

Nuckols Road between Energy Way and Springfield Road

Anticipated Cost:

\$1,700,000

The project costs are estimates and subject to change as the project design is further developed. The project is being financed with federal and local funds.

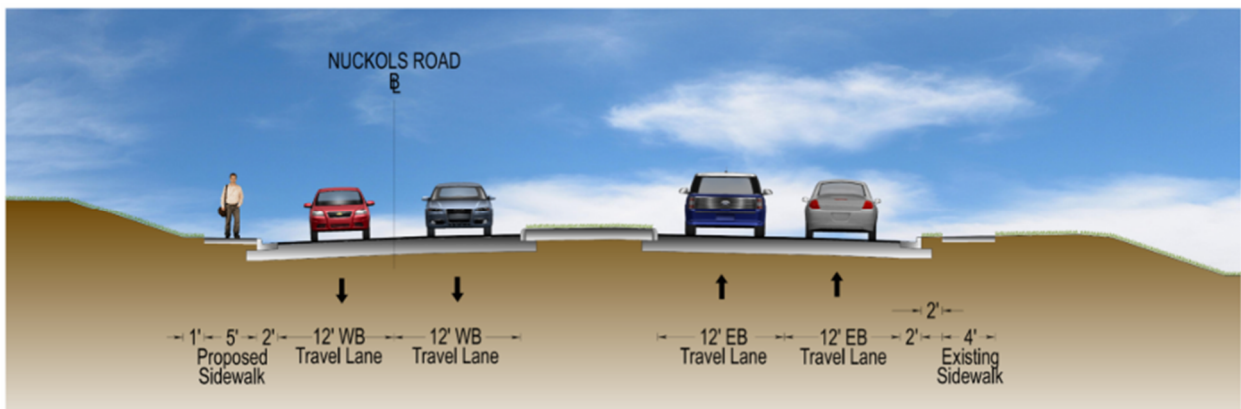
Anticipated Schedule:

Right of Way

Displays at this meeting show the extent of right of way that will be needed as the project is currently proposed. Property owners will be informed of the exact location of the easements during the right of way acquisition process and prior to construction.

Environmental Review

The County has performed environmental reviews and coordination to obtain information about environmental resources in the project vicinity; to provide natural and historic resource agencies an opportunity to review and comment on the project during its development, and to identify opportunities for avoidance, minimization and mitigation of potential environmental impacts.

The National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) is applicable to this project and a NEPA

document has been developed in cooperation with VDOT and the Federal Highway Administration and in accordance with federal guidelines. The NEPA document includes information from various technical reviews including those related to natural resources, water quality, threatened and endangered species, air quality, noise, etc.

The project will continue to be coordinated with the appropriate federal, state, and local agencies as part of the environmental review and approval processes required throughout project development and construction. All required environmental clearances and permits will be obtained prior to commencement of construction. Strict compliance with all environmental conditions and commitments resulting from regulatory approvals, and implementation of the County's specifications and standard best practices will protect the environment during construction.

The NEPA document and the results of other environmental studies are available at today's meeting. Representatives from the County are available to discuss this information and to answer questions.

Civil Rights

Representatives from the County are present to discuss the project and answer your questions. It is the responsibility of the County to ensure that all members of the community are afforded the opportunity to provide comments and participate in public decisions on projects affecting them. The County ensures nondiscrimination in all programs and activities in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

The public comment period will close on May 9 2025, following the public hearing. County representatives will review and evaluate any information received.
