Project Overview



Anticipated Cost – \$5,244,536

Purpose – Proposed plans include adding a sidewalk on N. Parham Rd. from Homeview Dr. to Skipwith Rd. and installing a traffic signal at the intersection of N. Parham Rd. and Homeview Dr.

From – .006 miles west of Homeview Dr.

To – .327 miles east of Homeview Drive

Total length – 1,500 ft (.28 mi)

Improvements – Replacing traffic signal mast arm, installing a signal, and adding a sidewalk.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The proposed project will improve safety and reduce congestion.

This proposed project will build an eastbound right turn lane on Parham Road at Skipwith Road. Additionally, a half mile of sidewalk will be installed with handicap-accessible ramps on the southside of Parham Road. A traffic signal with pedestrian crossing equipment and crosswalks will be installed at Parham Road and Homeview Drive. The signal at Parham Road and Skipwith Road will be replaced. Bicycle racks and a transit information kiosk will be added to the Parham Road Park & Ride lot.

Environmental Review

This project has been coordinated through the State Environmental Review Process (SERP). The SERP provides state environmental resource agencies an opportunity to comment on the highway improvements at the initial stages of the project. Comments and concerns from the state agencies participating in SERP will be considered as the project develops.

Right of Way

As the design is developed, VDOT will determine what right of way and easements will be needed to accommodate the construction. The right of way and easement information will be available at the public hearing planned for June 21. The property owners will be notified of the exact location of the right of way and easements needed during the right of way acquisition process and prior to construction.
