***The Asian tiger mosquito is laying eggs
in CONTAINERS in YOUR YARD and
NEIGHBORHOOD!***

- ◆ *They are significant daytime biting pests*
- ◆ They lay eggs in containers and other man-made items that collect water
- ◆ They DO NOT lay eggs in ponds, ditches, streams or swamps
- ◆ They have a short flight range, about 100 yards
- ◆ If they are biting you, they are laying eggs nearby
- ◆ They develop into adults in about 10 days
- ◆ You are important in their control, therefore



*From May through October
PICK ONE DAY A WEEK
to check for breeding sites
on your property!*

Protect yourself from mosquito bites:

- Use mosquito repellent
 - Carefully follow the directions
 - EPA-registered active ingredients include: DEET, Picaridin, IR3535, and Lemon Eucalyptus
- Wear long-sleeved loose fitting shirts and long pants
