ABOUT CRIME DATA

The data contained in this crime report utilizes Part I Crime Reporting based on Uniform Crime Reporting guidelines established by the Federal Bureau of Investigations (FBI).

Part I Crime encompasses both violent and property-related offenses reported in Henrico County, Virginia. Part I Violent Crime includes criminal homicide, rape, robbery and aggravated assault. Part I Non-Violent Crime includes burglary, larceny, automobile theft and arson.

Crime rate data for 2017 is based on the most current Henrico County Planning 3-C population estimate of 332,368.









VIOLENT OFFENSES BY TYPE













NON-VIOLENT OFFENSES BY TYPE













Includes weapons that were confiscated, seized as evidence, found and recovered.







DRUGS SEIZED IN 2017









TOTAL CHARGES











TOTAL ADULT CHARGES











TOTAL CALLS FOR SERVICE











Traffic charges data from UCR code 2700; includes infractions, misdemeanors and felonies.







Arrests includes adult and juvenile violations of 18.2-266 and 18.2-266.1.









■ Part I Crime Rate Per 1,000 Residents











■ Part I Crime Rate Per 1,000 Residents













■ Part I Crime Rate Per 1,000 Residents











■ Part I Crime Rate Per 1,000 Residents










