**Public Information Meeting**

November 28, 2018

**Purpose of the Project:**

- The purpose of the project is to maintain the reliability of the sewer collection system in the area by replacing or rehabilitating deteriorated sewer piping installed in the 1960s. The area is located in the Chamberlayne Farms and Chamberlayne Hills Subdivisions in the area approximately bounded by E. Parham Road to the north, Wilkinson Road to the south, Dade Road to the west, and Diane Road to the east.

**Scope of Work:**

- Rehabilitate approximately 6.6 miles of sewer piping.
- Replace approximately 900 linear feet of sewer piping.
- Replace/rehabilitate approximately 435 sanitary sewer service laterals
- Repave the area of the streets where "open cutting" is performed upon completion of the utility work.

**Construction Topics:**

- The construction contractor, Enviroscope, Inc., will start work the week of December 31, 2018 and will complete the work by February 2021, weather permitting.
- Normal working hours will be 7 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday thru Saturday. Typically, work will not occur on Sunday or County Holidays. Unless otherwise approved, lane closures on arterial and collector roads (Chamberlayne Road, Wilkinson Road, Diane Lane, St. Charles Road, Upham Drive) will be permitted only between 9:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m
- If a street closure is needed, a detour with signs will be provided around the block. All lanes must be re-opened to traffic at the end of each workday
- Access to homes will be maintained for residents. When traveling in the area, everyone is urged to drive with caution while crews complete the work.
