Did you know...

When you call the police to report a crime you do not have to give your name or be seen by the responding officer?

When calling police, it is important to give as much information as possible such as:

- What is the location of the incident?
- How many people are involved?
- Are there weapons involved?
- Description of the parties involved to include:
 - Gender
 - Race
 - Height
 - Weight
 - Color and style of clothing
- Which way did the subjects travel?
 - Are they on foot or in a car?
 - If they are in a car try to provide the make, color and license plate.

If you are reporting an emergency, dial 911. For any non-emergency needs dial (804) 501-5000. You may also file police reports via the internet for certain incidents via the [“Duty Officer Reporting System”](#) (DORS).

File reports for incidents such as:

- Annoying Phone calls/Text/Emails
 - Auto Tampering
 - Fraud/ Check Fraud/Credit Card Fraud
 - Embezzlement
 - Identity Theft
 - Larceny (Under \$15,000)
 - Lost Property
 - Suspicious Situations
 - Vandalism (Not Graffiti)
