**Yes!**

Metal food cans should be rinsed and put in your recycle bin.



**Yes!**

Food cartons should be rinsed and put in your recycle bin.



**Yes!**

Aluminum pie plates should be rinsed and put in your recycle bin.



**No!**

Plastic bags and plastic film should be returned clean and dry to retail stores.



**Yes!**

Glass jars should be rinsed and put in your recycle bin.



**Yes!**

Cardboard food boxes should be put in your recycle bin.

**No!**

Metal lids should be thrown away.
