The County of Henrico Department of Public Works welcomes you to the public hearing for the proposed Woodman Road Improvements project. The purpose of this public hearing is to give an opportunity for citizens or organizations to provide comments on the proposed project. The County wants all members of the community to have the opportunity to participate in public involvement on projects affecting them. The County representatives are present to discuss the project and answer your questions. This project may involve a change in limited access control at the intersection of Woodman Road and Mountain Road at the I-295 interchange. Comments can either be submitted using the form included in this handout or via the County's website (accessible by scanning the QR code in the Contact Information section). County staff will address all questions and concerns raised as a result of this public hearing.

North of Hungary Road to South of Mountain Road

Length:

1.75 miles

Purpose:

To improve safety and access along Woodman Road for motorists, while accommodating the needs of pedestrians and cyclists.

Utility Relocation: August 2029

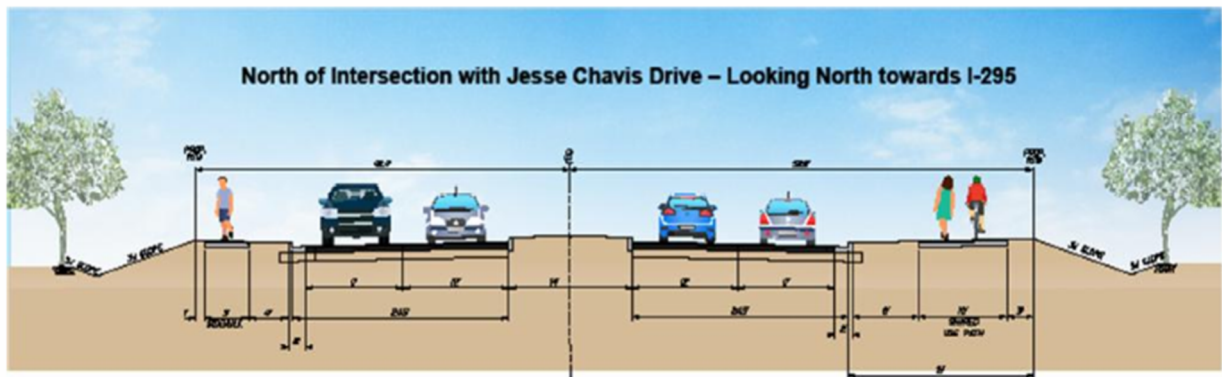
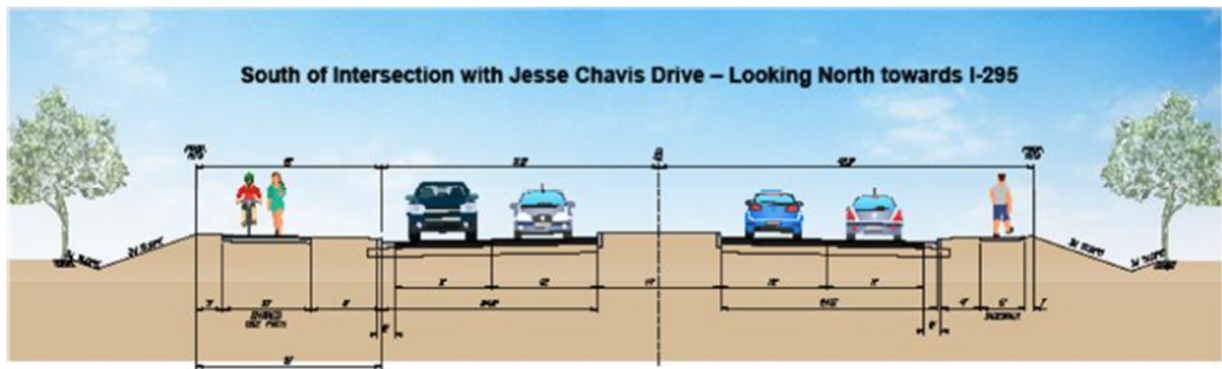
Begin Construction: Spring 2030

Project Description

The County of Henrico is proposing to improve 1.75 miles of Woodman Road to provide a four-lane divided roadway between Hungary Road and Mountain Road. The project includes turn lane improvements, a shared use path, and sidewalk along the corridor. Pedestrian crossings with push buttons and count down timers will be provided at each signalized intersection. The project is being designed as an urban-low speed, minor arterial roadway with a 35-mph speed limit.

Right of Way

Displays at this meeting show the extent of right of way that will be needed as the project is currently proposed. Property owners will be informed of the exact location of the easements during the right of way acquisition process and prior to construction.

Environmental Review

The County has performed environmental reviews and coordination with state and federal agencies to obtain information about environmental resources in the project vicinity. Also, to provide natural and historic resource agencies an opportunity to review and comment on the project during its development, and to identify opportunities for avoidance, minimization, and mitigation of potential environmental impacts. The project is being coordinated with the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) as part of the state environmental review process. This review process will include a review of the potential impacts to threatened or endangered species within the vicinity of the project.

Civil Rights

Representatives from the County are present to discuss the project and answer your questions. It is the responsibility of the County to ensure that all members of the community are afforded the opportunity to provide comments and participate in public decisions on projects affecting them. The County ensures nondiscrimination in all programs and activities in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

The public comment period will close on August 15, 2025, following the public hearing. County representatives will review and evaluate any information received.
