

2002

With Virginia in a historic drought, Henrico, Cumberland and others discuss potential reservoir to augment flows in the James River.

2010

Henrico and Cumberland approve memorandum of understanding.

2013

All property for the reservoir acquired by Henrico.

2015-2017

Gas and electrical utilities relocated on site.

2017

Construction of dam and facilities begins.

2022

Reservoir could start releases to augment flows in the James River.

2006-2007

Key state and federal permits approved.

2011

Engineering begins.

2016

Design of dam and facilities substantially completed.

2021

Reservoir is expected to begin filling.
