Belmont Golf Course Update

Patty Merrill, Vice Chairman of the Board of Directors of First Tee of Greater Richmond, gave a brief overview of the mission of First Tee to maximize youth participation, increase community awareness, expand the facility footprint, enhance financial sustainability, and enhance organizational leadership at the Belmont Golf Course. The goal is to make Belmont an affordable, inclusive, community-focused facility. Bert Schneider, CEO of First Tee of Greater Richmond, reviewed the timeline for renovations. The grand opening is planned for May 24, 2021.


Mr. Schneider shared aerial photos of the course renovations and stated First Tee hopes to start offering programs to the community this summer. First Tee is working with Schools, Recreation and Parks, and the Henrico PAL program. In addition, it is working on league competition and the Women's LPGA Executive Women's League. Mr. Schneider reviewed the rates and shared the marketing logos.

Neil Luther, Director of Recreation and Parks, told the Board that Hermitage High School previously played all its matches at Belmont and the County's goal is to work with high school coaches to have their teams play at Belmont.
