Gentlemen:

The Board of Supervisors at its meeting on January 9, 1980, pursuant to your request and upon recommendation of the Planning Commission, granted Colonial Stores, Inc., a Provisional Use Permit to continuously operate its store in the Fairfield Shoppers' World Shopping Center.

In accordance with Subsection 9.42a, Section 9.4 of Article 9 of Henrico County Zoning Ordinance No. 179, the Provisional Use Permit is nontransferrable and is revocable by the Board of Supervisors if the extended hours of usage are found to have a deleterious effect on the neighborhood.

The Planning Office has been advised of the action of the Board of Supervisors and requested to revise its records accordingly and to place a copy of this approval in the Provisional Use Permit Index.
