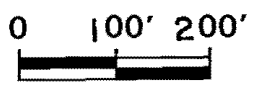

Dear Mr. Layman:

The Board of Supervisors at its meeting on July 13, 1994, granted your request for a revocable Provisional Use Permit in order to operate a recycling collection facility, Part of Parcel 86-A1-60, West Park Shopping Center, subject to the following conditions:

1. No recyclable materials or other items may be stored outside of the trailers. Any materials deposited outside of the collection facility during off-hours shall be picked up regularly and removed from the site. The pickup shall not be less than once per day, 365 days per year.
2. A site plan for the proposed collection facility shall be submitted for administrative approval within thirty (30) days of approval of this permit.
3. Should this collection facility cease to operate for any period of more than sixty (60) days, this permit shall become null and void.
4. A sign shall be posted at this collection facility to clearly identify the types of materials or items that may be accepted. It must state that no items may be deposited or left after hours of operation. The sign shall clearly state the hours of operation and provide an emergency telephone number.
5. The collection facility shall be attended during hours of operation in accordance with the Operation and Maintenance Plan.
6. A tonnage collection report for a six-month period shall be submitted to the Planning Office no later than January 15 and July 15 of each year.
7. The exact location and area of the collection facility shall be as approved by this request.
8. Any change to the Operation and Maintenance Plan shall be subject to review by the Director of Planning.
