

Re: Provisional Use Permit P-31-96

Dear Mr. Standard:

The Board of Supervisors at its meeting on March 26, 1997, granted your request for a revocable Provisional Use Permit in order to extend ours of operation to 2:00 a.m. on Part of Parcel 70-9-A-1, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The bowling center and billiard parlor may remain open to the public until 2:00 a.m. only on Saturday mornings and Sunday mornings.
- Customers shall be required by management to leave the premises, including parking areas, immediately after the close of business.
- 3. There will be two (2) uniformed security officers provided on the premises after 9:00 p.m. on Friday and Saturday nights (one inside and one outside the premises), and one (1) on the premises on Sunday night. At least one security officer shall remain on the premises until customers of the bowling center and billiard parlor have left the premises, including parking areas, after the bowling center and billiard parlor are closed to the public. Such security officers shall either be off-duty police officers or licensed security guards employed by a licensed security service company.
- 4. The operation of the bowling center and billiard parlor shall not cause loitering, criminal assaults or public nuisance in the area surrounding the business.
- 5. A parking lot lighting plan to enhance site lighting shall be submitted for approval by the Director of Planning within thirty (30) days after approval of this provisional use permit. Lighting fixtures as shown on the approved lighting plan shall be installed within ninety (90) days following approval of the provisional use permit.

- 6. A closed circuit television site monitoring system and video recording equipment (VCR, switching device and tapes to record information from all cameras) shall be submitted for approval by the Director of Planning within thirty (30) days after approval of this provisional use permit. The approved monitoring system shall be installed within ninety (90) days following approval of the provisional use request. The monitoring system shall include the following features:
 - (a) Surveillance cameras shall be in operation after 6:00 p.m., until the close of business, nightly.
 - (b) Tapes recording activities observed by the surveillance cameras shall be preserved for a period of six (6) months. Authorized representatives of the Henrico County Police Department or the Henrico County Planning Department shall have access to such tapes, upon written request.

The Planning Office has been advised of the action of the Board of Supervisors and requested to revise its records and to place a copy of this notification in the Provisional Use Permit Index.
