## Dear Mr. Savage:

The Board of Supervisors at its meeting on May 13, 2003, granted your request for a Provisional Use Permit in order to permit an outside dining area, on part of Parcel 749-759-5776, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. No outside live music performances shall be permitted.
- 2. Any outside speakers or sound system shall comply with the following standards:
  - a. Sound systems must be equipped with controls permitting full volume adjustment.
  - b. Sound from the system shall not be audible beyond 100 feet from the source.
  - c. Sound systems may be used only when outside dining is permitted.
- 3. The outdoor dining area shall be limited to no more than 850 square feet and constructed as shown on "The Summit: Floor Plan" submitted with this Provisional Use Permit application (see case file).
- 4. Trash receptacles shall be provided and properly serviced to control litter generated by this use.
- 5. Access to the outdoor dining area shall be available only through the restaurant; patrons may not gain access directly from the adjacent parking area, except that an emergency exit may be provided.

- 6. The approval of this Provisional Use Permit (PUP) is subject to the applicant obtaining a Plan of Development (POD) for this site.
- 7. Operation of the outdoor dining area shall not occur between the hours of 10:00 pm and 7:00 am.

The Planning Office has been advised of the action of the Board of Supervisors and requested to revise its records and to place a copy of this notification in the Provisional Use Permit Index.
