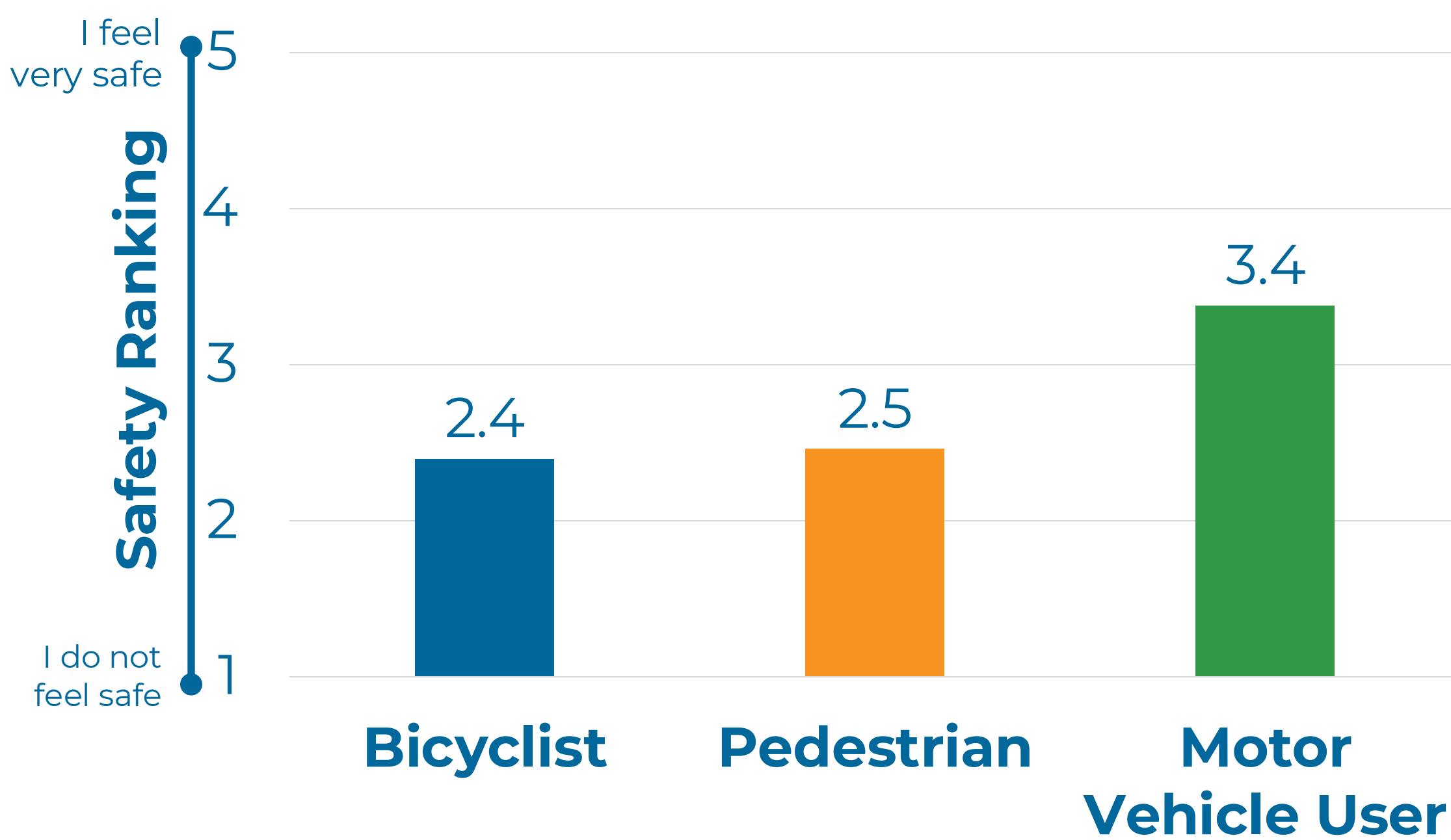


In partnership with the public, the project team identified transportation safety concerns in Spring 2024.

Recommended strategies and solutions

Participants recommended strategies and solutions to the project team based on **Engineering**, **Education**, and **Enforcement**. Responses included:

Engineering Solutions

Install streetlights across the County! As a firefighter for the County, I am often turning on the fire engine's flood lights to improve visibility on two lane roads like Hillard and Dumbarton.

Expand sidewalks, implement traffic calming, road-diet overbuilt roads, speed camera enforcement where legal, install protected bike lanes.

Educational Programs

More community engagement and school involvement. We can ask kids for ideas to make education campaigns or places for engineering improvements.

I think that one of the best ways to improve roadways is to raise awareness, particularly in high-risk areas (i.e., road work, high traffic areas) so that drivers are prepared and can respond accordingly to difficulties.

Traffic Enforcement

Safety is critical: reducing speed limit in small community, install speed camera in school zone, share crash data, expand sidewalk.
